Agreement of Partnership for scientific and educational collaboration between the Institute of Pediatrics-Department of Medical Sciences, University of Foggia (School of Medicine), Viale Pinto 1, Foggia, 71100, Italy, and the Department of Pediatrics, State University of New York at Buffalo, Women and Children's Hospital of Buffalo, 219 Bryant Street, Buffalo, NY 14222-2006, USA.

This Agreement of partnership shall foster educational and scientific collaboration between the Institute of Pediatrics-Department of Medical Sciences of the University of Foggia (School of Medicine), Italy and the Department of Pediatrics, State University of New York at Buffalo, USA.

The main purpose of this program of Collaboration is to encourage educational and scientific collaboration between the two Pediatric Centers.

The two Pediatric University Centers represented respectively by their Chiefs desire to memorialize the following specific aspects of their relationship; and agree to the following:

The Institute of Pediatrics-Department of Medical Sciences, University of Foggia and the Department of Pediatrics, State University of New York at Buffalo enter into this Agreement of Cooperation, the aim of which is scientific and educational collaboration.

This Agreement has the following aims:

- 1. to promote scientific relations between the faculty/staff members and of the two pediatric Centers. Planning and performing scientific and/or educational projects of mutual interest, particularly in an interdisciplinary perspective.*
- 2. the exchange of scientific information between the fellow residents of the two Centers within the framework of such projects.*
- 3. the organization of initiatives of mutual interest, i.e. conferences and seminars.*
- 4. the exchange of publications and information, and the editing of joint publications resulting from the activities listed above.*

The present agreement involves no financial obligation for the two parties.
